- Birth certificate showing that the student was born in the United States
- Certificate of Birth Abroad FS-545, DS-1350, or FS-240
- U.S. Passport
- Certificate of Citizenship (N-560 or N-561) or Certificate of Naturalization (N-550 or N-570)

(Department of Homeland Security (DHS) allows these documents to be photocopied for verification of citizenship.)

ELIGIBLE NON-CITIZEN - I am an eligible non-citizen and am providing one of the following documents from the DHS:

- U.S. permanent resident.** You must provide an Alien Registration Receipt Card (I-151 or I-551), or a Passport stamped "Processed for I-551".
- Other eligible non-citizen.** You must provide an I-94 stamped as one of the following: (a) "Refugee," (b) "Asylum Granted," (c) Individual Paroled into the U.S. for at least one year (d) "Cuban-Haitian Entrant" OR an I-688B (I-688B may or may not allow you to be eligible, this requires further Department of Homeland Security documentation by our office.), (e) Victims of Human trafficking (T-visa).
- Citizen of the Marshall Island, Federal States of Micronesia, or Palau.** You must provide a document (Passport, birth certificate, etc.) which identifies you as a legal resident of the area.

NOTE: You are **INELIGIBLE** to receive federal student aid if you are any one of the following:

- An applicant for permanent resident status not in a category listed above.
- A student with an F1 or F2 (student visa), J1 or J2 (exchange visitor) or L or G series Visa.
- A student in the United States with only an Employment Verification and Authorization Documents (Form I-688A, I- 688B, I-766) or Temporary Resident Card (Form I-688).

Be sure to **include both sides** of the document you are sending (make sure copies are legible).

Student Certification: I certify that I am the student represented in the documents photocopied and attached. I understand that false statements or misrepresentations may be reported to the U.S. Attorney General and will affect my eligibility for student aid.
