Appeal of Termination of Federal Financial Aid Eligibility

Students are evaluated at the end of each spring semester to determine if they are meeting Academic Progress for Federal financial aid. Students who are not meeting one or more standards at the time of the evaluation are ineligible for Federal financial aid.

Students not meeting one or more of the standards are eligible to submit an appeal to the office of Student Financial Services.

Section A: Student Appeal Statement

- Provide a clear and concise (500 word maximum) statement as to what caused the lack of satisfactory progress
- Supporting documentation is required for medical condition(s) or family death(s)
- Washington University transcripts are not required. Academic transcripts for other institutions may be submitted
- You may attach additional pages and/or documentation (recommended)

Section B: Student Corrective Action

- State what corrective actions you have taken and will take to meet and maintain Federal Satisfactory Academic Progress standards (changes in program, tutoring, study time, etc.)
- You may attach additional pages and/or documentation (emails with advisors, academic plans, etc)
- Please limit statements to 500 words or less

Completed appeals will be reviewed by the appeal committee and are final. Students will learn the results of their appeal by email, generally within 10 days of the submission.
